

Memorandum of Association

The name of the Society is the "**H**" **Division Mounted Police Pipes and Drums Society**

The objects of the society are:

- (a) To represent the RCMP, by serving as a good will ambassador through the performance of Pipe & Drum music in the community ('Community Through Involvement').
- (b) To provide recreation and education for band members through the practice and performance of Pipe & Drum music.
- (c) To be self-funded through various band, mini-band and single member performance engagements, as well as through public donations.
- (d) To maintain operational and administration activities of the Band, at arms-length from the RCMP, through the Society.
- (e) To acquire by way of grant, gift, purchase, bequest, devise or otherwise, real and personal property and to use and apply such property to the realization of the objects of the Society;
- (f) To buy, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or desirable in the carrying out of the objects of the Society.

Provided that nothing herein contained shall permit the Society to carry on any trade, industry, or business and the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain to any of the members and that any surplus or any accretions of the Society shall be used solely for the purposes of the Society and the promotion of its objects.

Provided, further, that if for any reason the operations of the Society are terminated or are wound up, or are dissolved and there remains, at that time, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall be paid to some other charitable organization in Canada, having objects similar to those of the Society.

The activities of the Society are to be carried on primarily in Nova Scotia with some performance in other jurisdictions (as required).




